CONDUCT

- I will play soccer because I want to, not because others want me to.
- I will play by the rules of soccer, and in the spirit of the game.
- Always show respect to coaches, teammates, opponents, and referees.
- Attend all scheduled practices and games on time and be prepared to train.
- Give your best effort in every session, regardless of the situation.
- Control emotions and avoid unnecessary physical aggression.

GAMES AND PRACTICES

- If I cannot make a game or practice, I will notify the team Coach at least 48 hours in advance so that arrangements for substitutes can be made.
- I realize that players who attend practices may get priority in the game starting line-up. Starting line-ups are based on several factors including attendance at practices, player's position, effort, attitude, etc.
- I will leave all venues as neat and tidy as I found and will remove all refuse from my area.
- I do understand that the way I practice will be the way I will perform in the game, so 100% of my effort will be given.
- I realize that playing time is not always going to be equal despite my coaches attempt to equalize. In fact, some teams (higher level Competitive teams) are permitted to use an earned playing time system. At the development and recreation levels, playing time shall be equitable

RESPECT
